



The 100AW Performance Rally Group is introducing the 2019 Eastern Ozark Rally Cup (EeyORe Cup) for its friends and family.

As rallying has grown up in Missouri over the past 42 years (yes kids we rallied in 1977 on some of the same roads we're racing on today) our family has grown to dozens and dozens of key committee people, dozens of rally teams, hundreds of rally day volunteers, more and more communities and even the occasional new counties (welcome Shannon County...although, truth be told we ran in Shannon County in the 1970's...so welcome back!).

We decided to create an inclusive award bringing our volunteers and our competitors together since we're all becoming more and more acquainted and more and more co-responsible for our genuine fun.

The EeyORe Cup will award points to volunteers, committee folks and competitors over the year (starting back at MOR in February....we will back track and figure the points accumulated there after the dust settles at 100 Acre Wood).

We will count points for finishing positions on Regional events (and although ARA is not counting Trespassers Wil as two events this year, the EeyORe Cup will....so there are two opportunities to register points at 100AW).

Events counting toward the Cup are:

- Missouri Ozark Rally
- Trespassers Wil Friday
- Trespassers Wil Saturday
- Show-Me

Points will be awarded in 2 classes, 2WD and AWD and multiple volunteer positions depending on their level of responsibility....

It has not been decided where or when we will have a celebration of our 2019 season, but it could happen at Show-Me in October, MOR in January, or we could pick a date some other time and have a party. But we will celebrate our family!

Below is the point distribution rationale for the 2019 EeyOre Cup.

2nd in Class	17	Volunteer Coordinator

4th in Class	12	Assigned and working ATC, FTC, or MTC, Scoring...involved in Timing
5th in Class	10	Spectator Marshal, Service Marshal, HAM Radio
6th in Class	8	Any other Marshal Position
7th in Class	6	
8th in Class	5	Course Opening (000,00,0), Any Sweep Position, Green Light, etc.
9th in Class	4	
10th in Class	3	
11th in Class	2
